When the day is fine, skies are clear and blue, pack the car , (don't forget your camera) and take a drive south to Laurieton.

North Brother Mountain overlooks Laurieton, North Haven and Dunbogan villages. At the summit, in Dooragan National Park, is the lookout accessible via sealed roads.

Take a picnic as they have excellent facilities and these have to be some of the country's most spectacular views. Three walks of varying length and difficulty are available if you are feeling energetic.

The mountain supports a wide range of vegetation communities, including some of the best examples of old growth blackbutt forest in NSW and pockets of sub-tropical rainforest, that provide habitat for gliders, bats and koalas.
